1. The committee met at 9:10am in the school hall.
2. All bags of waste were in the hall ready to sort.
3. The children divided into teams with the adults and sorted the waste into 2 areas - waste and recycling
(clean only)
4. When all of the waste was sorted, we divided the waste rubbish into categories of blue roll, hand tissues and general waste
5. The waste was then weighed.
6. Green Schools Meeting called for Monday 24th to put this information up on our Green Schools Board and to create our new target for our Action Plan 2026 and to decide how we will tell the rest of the school.
